C. Project extent and activity:

The proposed project activity involves about 100 % of the pit area for exploring building stone. At the end of life of mine, excavated pit will be backfilled and reclaimed and rehabilitated by plantation leaving no void. The proposed project does not involve any underground mining activities .The mining will be done by open cast semi mechanized method. The sewage of 0.8 KLD generated from the mine office will be diverted to the septic tank followed by soak pit.

Mr. Mohammed Fazeel T.A. has applied for Environmental Clearance vide application received on 09-12-2013 for the quarry project of M/s Royal Sand & Gravels Pvt. Ltd. in Sy. Nos. 2, 14, 15 and 16/1 at Akathethara Village and Panchayath, Palakkad Taluk, Palakkad District, Kerala from 9.3928 hectares for the extraction of minor minerals. The land use classification as per revenue records is private land. Out of the total 11.6655 hectares of land owned by the proponent, the lease area consists of 9.3928 hectares which is private land and the present land use is quarrying activities. The current proposal is for the existing quarry and hence no alternate site was examined as the project site is mineral specific. The proposed quarry site is private land and is possessed in the name of M/s Royal Sand & Gravels Pvt. Ltd. Forest land is not involved in the project. The proposal has been appraised by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee Kerala constituted by the competent authority, as per prescribed procedure in the lights of provisions under the EIA Notification 2006 and subsequent amendments, in its 23rd meeting held on 6th and 7th January 2014, 25th meeting held on 14th and 15th February 2014, 26th meeting held on 20th and 21st March 2014 and 29th meeting held on 2nd and 3rd May 2014 AND on the basis of the supporting documents enclosed with the application viz., the Form – 1, questionnaire for mining projects, pre-feasibility report, Environment Management Plan and the additional clarifications including a map showing a buffer distance of 50 m from the forest land on the north furnished in response to the observations, the SEAC Kerala recommended environmental clearance to the project.

The proposed project activity involves about 100 % of the pit area for exploring building stone. At the end of life of mine, excavated pit will be backfilled and reclaimed and rehabilitated by plantation leaving no void. The proposed project does not involve any underground mining activities. The mining

will be done by open cast semi mechanized method. The bench height and width proposed is 5 m. The exploitation of mineral is being done from 225 m MSL to 125 m MSL in conceptual phase. The ultimate depth of the mine workings is estimated to be 125 m MSL. Part of the proposed land is already under mining and there is no top soil in those areas. The remaining land is having top soil with average thickness of 1 m to 3 m. About 1,55,440 m³ of top soil will be generated from the proposed pit, which will be properly stacked within their own property but outside the lease area and will be utilized for plantation over the reclaimed areas. The sewage of 0.8 KLD generated from the mine office will be diverted to the septic tank followed by soak pit. The municipal solid waste generated from the labour quarter will be disposed. The sludge generated from the septic tank will be dried and used as manure in plantation. The daily water requirement of 5 KLD will be met from open well water/storm water collection pond. The total power requirement of 75 kW will be drawn from diesel engine. There will be fugitive emissions generated during material handling, transportation, loading, unloading, etc. that are proposed to be managed by regular water sprinkling on haul road, green belt development, avoiding overloading of vehicles, maintaining the speed of vehicles within prescribed limits and covering the load with tarpaulin sheets. Plantation with shrubs, herbs and trees will be done as part of eco-restoration work. Anticipating 50 % growth rate, at the end of life of mine about 9,000 trees will be grown in total area of 9.3928 hectares. As per the biodiversity listing provided by the proponent, there is no floral or faunal species existing at site which are in the red listed category or schedule 1 species. Kalpathi Puzha is located at a distance of 8 km S, thodu at a distance of 2 km S, a water fall at a distance of 2 km SE, Dhoni Forest at 7.5 m N & E and Malampuzha Dam Water Catchment Area at a distance of 2.4 km NE of the project site. Electrical high tension line is at a distance of 700 m W and Mobile tower at a distance of 1 km W of the project site. There are no houses within 500 m radius from the proposed quarry. The quarry is interlinked with a crusher unit located within the complex. As stated by the proponent, there is no litigation pending against the lease area / applicant of the lease area in any court of law. The total cost of the project is ₹ 2.50 Crores.

The SEIAA, after due consideration of the relevant documents and additional clarifications submitted by the project proponent, and in view of the recommendations of SEAC, approved for issuance of Environmental Clearance for the project mentioned above at its 30th meeting held on 9th May 2014. Accordingly, the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) Kerala constituted by Govt. of India vide Notification No. S.O. 2484(E) dt. 3-11-2011 of Ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India, published as Gazette extraordinary No. 2074 on 3-11-2011 and further amended by Govt. of India vide Notification No. S.O. 546(E) dt.25.02.2014 of Ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India, published as Gazette extraordinary No. 466 dated 25-02-2014, hereby accord necessary Environmental Clearance for the quarry project in Sy. Nos. 2, 14, 15 and 16/1 at Akathethara Village and Panchayath, Palakkad Taluk, Palakkad District, Kerala by M/s Royal Sand & Gravels Pvt. Ltd. as per powers vested with it under the provisions of Environment Impact Assessment Notification – 2006 and subsequent amendments and also under the provisions made in the O.M. No. L-11011/47/2011-IA.II(M) dated 18th May 2012 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, and further subject to strict compliance of the following specific conditions, and the general conditions contained in the Annexure, which shall also form a part of this document:

- 1. Limit quarry to the stream on the eastern side to permit unhindered flow of the stream.
- 2. Leave statutory distance from the forest land on the north.
- 3. The stream may be pravided with low level check dams to trap silt.

BRIEF ON THE PROJECT ALONG WITH THE PRESENT STATUS:

Building stone quarry project of Sri. Mohammed Fazeel T.A has obtained Environmental Clearance (EC) from the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Kerala for quarrying of 3,50,000 MTA of building stone in from an area of 9.3928 hectares of land vide EC No. 160/SEIAA/KL/3490/2013 dated 24.05.2014 and subsequent Erratum vide No. 160/SEIAA/KL/3490/2013 dated 16.02.2019 at Akathethara Village and Panchayat, Palakkad Taluk, Palakkad District, Kerala. Based on verification of the EC Erratum dated 16.02.2019, it was noted that the validity of the EC is for a period of 15 years from 24.05.2019 subject to review in every 5 years.

This project site was inspected by the undersigned on 03.04.2024 and during the inspection, it was noted that the Quarry was in Operation and PP had a valid EC till 23.05.2029 subject to review in every 5 years from 24.05.2019. Based on records made available for verification, it was noted that PP has obtained permissions from other relevant agencies like Consent to Operate (CTO) from Kerala State Pollution Control Board (KSPCB) and the same is valid till 01.12.2024; Permission from Akathethara Grama Panchayat and the same is valid till 31.03.2025; Explosives License from PESO and the same is valid till 31.03.2025 and the mining lease was executed on 22.08.2014 for a period of 12 years and accordingly mining lease is valid till 21.08.2026 for an area of 7.0655 Ha and for an annual production of 1,00,000 MTA. Further, PP executed an additional Mining Lease on 12.02.2020, wherein the production capacity in Mining Lease was enhanced from 1,00,000 MTA to 3,00,000 MTA against a permitted quantity of 3,50,000 MTA in EC.

Further, it is also to note that the responsibility for ensuring compliance to these EC conditions is vested with concerned local enforcement agencies like District Collector, DMG, KSPCB etc. under various Acts like Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, Air Act, 1981, Water Act, 1974 etc. Based on the documents made available during and after the inspection for establishing compliance to EC conditions by the project authorities and as verified during the physical inspection of the project site, an inspection report is prepared detailing point wise compliance to EC Specific and General conditions as below:

On the day of inspection, the same could not be verified as there was no rain and water was not flowing from the seasonal streams. It was noted that de-siltation ponds are provided to clarify the storm water for avoiding silt from reaching the main streams and PP has been directed to ensure desiltation every year before the onset of Monsoon season. A check dam was also noted to exist in the quarry.
4	Rainwater harvesting facility is required in the absence of dependable source of water.	During the inspection, it was noted that PP has developed one pit as rainwater harvesting pit for storage of rainwater. The approximate dimension of the large pit is Length=20 Mtrs; Width=12 Mtrs and Depth=5 Mtrs. It was informed by the PP that this stored rainwater is being used for dust suppression of haulage roads and internal roads as well as for greenbelt/ avenue plantation. Further, it was also noted that KMBR/KPBR provisions of rainwater harvesting as per Chapter XVI-A are not fully applicable to quarry projects and no specific reference regarding the size of the rainwater harvesting pit mentioned in EC and the same needs to be ascertained by Local KMBR/KPBR related implementing agencies.

1.0 Examining Authority: The medical examination shall be carried out by a qualified medical practitioner in the employment of the mine or duly authorized for this purpose by the owner of mine or by Government medical officer , holding at least a degree in Bachelor of Medicines and Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S.) registered with National Medical Commission.

[PART II--SEC. 3(0)]

2.0 Identity of the candidate: The examining authority shall verify the identity of the candidate with Original documents of any one of the following: Aadhaar Card, Electors photo Identity Cards (EPIC), passport, driving licence, service identity card of state or central government, pension document with photograph or any government recognised identity card. He shall also check the Original Statutory Certificate issued by the Board of Mining Examinations before wedeally examining the candidate. Examinations before medically examining the candidate.

Standard and report of medical examination:

(i) For ascertaining the freedom of a person from deafness, defective vision or any other infirmity, mental or physical, likely to interfere with the efficient discharge of his duties, the examining authority shall medically examine the candidate in accordance with the standard laid down in the First Schedule of these bye-laws.

(ii) The examining authority shall prepare the medical report in the form as prescribed in Second Schedule of these bye-laws.

Unfit persons not to be employed: Where, as a result of medical examination made under clause 3.0, a 4.0 person has been declared unfit for employment in mines or in a particular category of mines or in any specified operations in mine, he shall not be employed or continue to be employed in a mine or in the category of mines.

Duties and Responsibilities of Owners, Agents and Managers: It shall be the duty of the owner, agent or 5.0 manager to ensure that no person shall act as a manager or an official or a blaster or a winding engineman in a mine after attaining the age of sixty years unless he has obtained, within the preceding one year, a medical certificate of fitness certifying him fit to carry out the duties prescribed for him in the Mines Act, 1952 and in the Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961 and orders made thereunder.
